The Hub's Program Lineup Receives Total of Three 2012 Daytime Emmy® Awards

LOS ANGELES - Todd Newton, from The Hub TV Network's top-rated, award-winning original series **"Family Game Night,"** was honored with a Daytime Emmy® Award for Outstanding Game Show Host when the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences (NATAS) announced this year's winners during the 39th Annual Daytime Entertainment Emmy® Awards ceremony in Los Angeles. Newton was also nominated for the award last year.
